

Ordinance #304

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF ASHLAND CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE ONE, TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN THE SALARIES OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS SUBSEQUENT TO THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Council of the City of Ashland City has determined that the public interest can best be served by amending the city's municipal code in order to increase the existing salaries of the Mayor, Council, and General Sessions Judge, provided that such increases shall not become effective during their current terms of elected office; and by adding a salary for the Board of Appeals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Council that the city of Ashland City Municipal Code shall be amended as follows:

1. Amend Title One (1), Chapter One (1), to include a new section 104, Compensation.

“The salaries of each Council member shall be \$75.00 per meeting.”

2. Amend Title One(1), Chapter two(2), to include a new section 203, Compensation.

“The salary of the Mayor shall be \$16,700.00 per year .”

3. Amend Title Three (3), Chapter One (1) Section 102, Subsection (9), Compensation.

Such section shall be amended by the deletion of “\$500 per month” and shall be replaced with “\$9,000.00 per year.”

4. Amend Title One (1), Chapter Two (2), to include a new section 204, Compensation.

“The salary of the Board of Appeals shall be \$50.00 per meeting.”

Such amendments not to be effective for elected officials until subsequent to the next regular municipal election next following adoption of this ordinance, at which time only those offices up for reelection shall qualify for this salary increase. The remaining members of the Council shall be eligible subsequent to the next election following aforementioned election.
