

Ordinance #205

An Ordinance of the Town of Ashland City adopting Underground Facilities requirements


Whereas, the following provisions are recommended by the Ashland City Planning Commission; and

Now Therefore Be It Ordained By The Mayor and City Council of The Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that the following read as follows:

From and after the effective date of this ordinance, any plans requiring the approval of the Ashland City Planning Commission for new structures or buildings to the city shall not be approved by the planning commission unless such plan or plans provide that all new utility facilities for electrical, gas, telephone, water, and other similar services, shall be placed underground.

This ordinance shall not apply to said utility facilities above ground existing within any subdivision heretofore platted or on which plans have heretofore been approved by the planning commission, or which existed prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect 20 days from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring such.
