

Resolution # 2008-01

Comes now the Mayor and City Council on this 12th day of February, 2008 pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 39-17-1311 moves to post signs at all city parks to be in compliance with the State statute to notify all parties entering the parks of their responsibilities not to carry weapons.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the following language shall be posted on signs at all city parks with the exception of Riverbluff Park and Bull Run Park (Bull Run Park is only applicable upon a lease agreement being approved):

"Pursuant to Tennessee code Annotated 39-17-1311 it is a misdemeanor to carry a weapon on the grounds of this park. State law prescribes a maximum penalty of eleven (11) months and twenty-nine (29) days and a fine not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for carrying weapons on or in public recreational property."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following language shall be posted on signs at Riverbluff Park and Bull Run Park (Bull Run Park is only applicable upon a lease agreement being approved):

"Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 39-17-1311 it is a misdemeanor to carry a weapon on the grounds of this park. State law prescribes a maximum penalty of eleven (11) months and twenty-nine (29) days and a fine not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for carrying weapons on or in public recreational property. The exception is long guns which are unloaded and properly cased at all times in transit to the boat ramp only with the sole purpose of leaving the facility by boat is permitted during legal hunting seasons. No person will be allowed to carry a weapon on any other areas of the park."
