

Resolution 2005-20

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE TO MAKE APPLICATION TO AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PROVISION OF THE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SCENIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENTS ON S.R. 49/CUMBERLAND STREET TO THE CHEATHAM RAILROAD CROSSING IN DOWNTOWN ASHLAND CITY, AND TO EXPRESS THE TIME WHEN THE RESOLUTION BECOMES EFFECTIVE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Council desire to provide scenic and environmental enhancements on S.R. 49/Cumberland Street and the Cheatham County Railroad Crossing in downtown Ashland City to support economic development and quality of life in Ashland City; and

**WHEREAS**, the scenic and environmental improvements are consistent with the Transportation Enhancement Program;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE**

Section 1: That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make application to and enter into agreement with the Tennessee Department of Transportation for funding under the provisions of the Transportation Enhancement Program for the purpose of providing scenic and environmental enhancements on S.R. 49/Cumberland Street and Cheatham County Railroad crossing in downtown Ashland City.


Section 2: That the Board of Mayor and Council of Ashland City, Tennessee, hereby agrees to obligate the necessary matching funds to satisfactorily complete the proposed project. Said obligation to be a minimum of twenty percent of the construction cost and the cost of design and engineering plans.

Section 3: This resolution to become effective from and after its adoption, the welfare of the town of Ashland City requiring it.
