

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO "THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE" AS CITED BELOW, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING THAT SUCH CHANGES BE IMPLEMENTED.

WHEREAS, the following provisions were recommended by the Ashland City Municipal Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted in this regard, as required by law by the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Ashland City on Aug. 13, 1996, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE: that "The Zoning Ordinance of Ashland City, Tennessee" is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE IV - GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 8. Other Automobile Storage Requirements

SUBSECTION 8.3

All off-street parking areas shall be surfaced with asphalt or concrete or other type of impervious surface capable of withholding the traffic load as deemed acceptable by the planning commission, and so constructed to provide for adequate drainage for all on and off-site affected properties such that stagnant pools of water are eliminated, as well as to prevent the release of siltation off the site. All parking spaces must be clearly marked.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE that this Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
