

Ordinance #159

An ordinance of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee adopting a policy limiting the sale of fireworks within the city limits of the Town of Ashland City.

Be It Ordained By the City Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that:

Section 1. Only the retail sale of fireworks shall be allowed within the corporate city limits of the Town of Ashland City and are restricted to the following times and places:

1. The sale of fireworks are prohibited except for the following days: June 20th thru July 5th and December 10th thru January 2nd.

2. Fireworks cannot be sold within 300 feet of a home, hospital, nursing home, or church.

Section 2. Be It Ordained that any dealer of fireworks must first obtain a permit from the City Recorder before setting up his/her business. The cost of the permit shall be \$75.00. Copies of the permit will be forwarded to the Ashland City Fire Chief by the Recorder. The Fire Chief shall have the responsibility of enforcing this ordinance.

Section 3. And Be It Also Ordained, That Any And All dealers must present said Recorder with copies of any and all State of Tennessee permits as required by Tennessee Code Annotated Chapter 104 before the city permit will be issued. The City's permit will reference the State Fire Marshall's permit number.

This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
