

ORDINANCE #109

WHEREAS, PUBLIC ACTS 1994, CHAPTER 648 REQUIRES THAT OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES OF CITIES OF 1,500 POPULATION PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF MUNICIPAL CLERK OR MUNICIPAL RECORDER BE CERTIFIED AFTER JULY 1, 1998;

WHEREAS, MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT IN TENNESSEE IN CITIES OF EVERY SIZE IS BECOMING MORE ADMINISTRATIVELY AND LEGALLY COMPLICATED, AND THE MUNICIPAL CLERKS AND RECORDERS ARE GENERALLY THE MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES WHO FIRST AND LONGEST IN TIME MEET AND DEAL WITH THAT COMPLEXITY;

WHEREAS, THE INCREASING COMPLEXITY OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT DEMANDS MUNICIPAL CLERKS AND RECORDERS TRAINED AND EDUCATED TO ANTICIPATE MUNICIPAL PROBLEMS BEFORE THEY HAPPEN AND TO RESOLVE THEM IN THE MOST ADMINISTRATIVELY AND LEGALLY SOUND MANNER POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, PUBLIC ACTS 1994, CHAPTER 648 PERMITS MUNICIPALITIES IN TENNESSEE BY ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THAT ITS RECORDER OR CLERK TO OBTAIN CERTIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY THAT ACT.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND CITY, THAT

SECTION 1. THE CITY OF ASHLAND CITY ADOPTS BY REFERENCE THE REQUIREMENTS OF PUBLIC ACTS 1994, CHAPTER 648, WHICH IS ATTACHED TO THIS ORDINANCE AND MADE A PART THEREOF AS IF IT WERE FULLY SET OUT IN THE TEXT OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON BEING PASSED AND ADOPTED ACCORDING TO ANY REQUIREMENTS SET OUT IN THE CITY'S CHARTER AND/OR MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES.
