

Ordinance #102

Ordinance to eliminate purchases by anyone other than City Employees:

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the City Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee to authorize payment of invoices, bills, etc. incurred by the City,

And to spend the tax payers monies in the most prudent manner,

And to account for such expenditures in detail,

And to spend only those funds which have been budgeted for,

Therefore, this Ordinance requires any and all such invoices, bills, etc. to be paid for with City funds to be made by purchase orders, only and that those purchase orders be given to City Employees only.

And that no person(s) not on the City payroll is authorized to buy equipment, parts, supplies, etc. in the name of "Town of Ashland City,"

And that any such purchases by anyone other than City Employees will not be paid for by the City, and that the person making such purchase shall be held fully accountable for such debt.

Said Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final passage the public welfare requiring it.
