

Ordinance #59

13-105-(1) Regulating tap fees for water service outside corporate limits.

An Ordinance to amend Section 13-105-(1a) of the Municipal Codes.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Ashland City, that section 13-105-(1a) of the Municipal Code, governing water tap rates be amended to read:

13-105. Tap fees for water service outside corporate limits.

(1) A fee or charge shall be made, and the same is hereby fixed and levied, for the privilege of connecting private water lines with, or tapping, the water lines or pipes, or water system, of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, located outside of the corporate limits as follows:

a. In each case or situation where a water meter 3/4"X5/8" in size is required or used in making such water line connection or tap the initial fee or charge shall be Seven hundred-fifty dollars (\$750.00) to be paid by the subscriber or customer. The foregoing \$750.00 fee applies to all connections or taps outside the corporate limits of the Town of Ashland City. In addition, each subscriber or customer shall be chargeable with and shall pay any and all extra or unusual costs or expenses incurred by said town in making said tap or water line connection on account of rocky terrain, boring under highways or roads, or any other unusual situation or condition requiring or necessitating the use of unusual services and/or machinery and equipment.

Said Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final passage the public welfare requiring it.
