

Ordinance #67

An Ordinance to amend the section of the Municipal Code regulating holiday procedures from holiday pay to compensation time.

An Ordinance to amend Chapter 8, section 1-805.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the Town of Ashland City that section 1-805 be amended to read:

1-805. Holidays . Personnel will observe the following holidays with a compensation day:

New Year's Day
Martin Luther King
Presidents Day
Good Friday
Memorial Day
Independence Day

Labor Day
Columbus Day
Veterans Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

All personnel, to be eligible for a compensation day, must work the regular work day immediately preceding and following the holiday, except where vacation leave is granted by the employee's immediate supervisor.

An employee required to work on one of the above named holidays shall be given a compensation day as prescribed along with his regular pay for the hours worked.

Sick leave taken on a regular work day immediately preceding or following a holiday must be substantiated by a doctor's certificate.

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
