

Ordinance #54

13-107-(1) Regulating water rates to the inhabitants of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee and areas covered by its water lines.

An Ordinance to amend Section 13-107-(1) of the Municipal Codes.

Be it ordained by the council of the Town of Ashland City, that section 13-107-(1) of the Municipal Code, Governing water rates be amended, to read:

13-107 Water and Sewer rates, charges and deposits.

(1) The charges and/or rates for water and/or water services provided and furnished by the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, to its inhabitants, and to all users of such water services, for each and every calender month of the year, are hereby adopted, fixed, and established as set forth in the following schedule, to wit:

Said Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final passage the public welfare requiring it.
