

ORDINANCE # 16

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE ZONING MAP OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE ON A SECTION OF TOWN FROM JEFFERSON STREET TO LENOX STREET, AND FROM THE PANCAKE HOUSE NORTH TO THE CITY LIMITS.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, that the Zoning map of Ashland City, Tennessee be changed from Residential-B to Commercial-B, the following described property: Beginning at a point in the intersection of Jefferson and North Main Streets, thence westwardly along Jefferson Street to an alley, thence with said alley Northwardly and continuing in a straight line to Lenox Street; thence easterly with Lenox Street to North Main Street, thence in a southerly direction to the beginning point. Beginning at a point on an access road and Railroad in the Northern section of Town, and continuing with said Railroad in a Northwesterly direction to Mark's Creek, thence up Mark's Creek to # 12 Highway, thence in a south-easterly direction with #12 Highway to the intersection of the old Clarksville Highway, that goes behind the State and County Garages, along said road to the intersection with #12 Highway, thence in a northwesterly direction with #12 Highway to the beginning point.
