

Ordinance # 485a

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE 17/18 FISCAL YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee is adopting a budget amendment for the fiscal year July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$15,000 out of the fund balance for the Drug Fund for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$8,925 for the Tennessee Highway Safety Grant as part of the reimbursement grant contract with Resolution 2017-30; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$4,800 for the Tennessee Highway Safety Grant as part of the reimbursement grant contract with Resolution 2017-25; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$67,222 for the SAFER Volunteer Grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that this ordinance shall become effective 20 days after final passage the public welfare requiring.

Section 1. A budget amendment consisting of the available funds and appropriations be adopted for the General Fund:
